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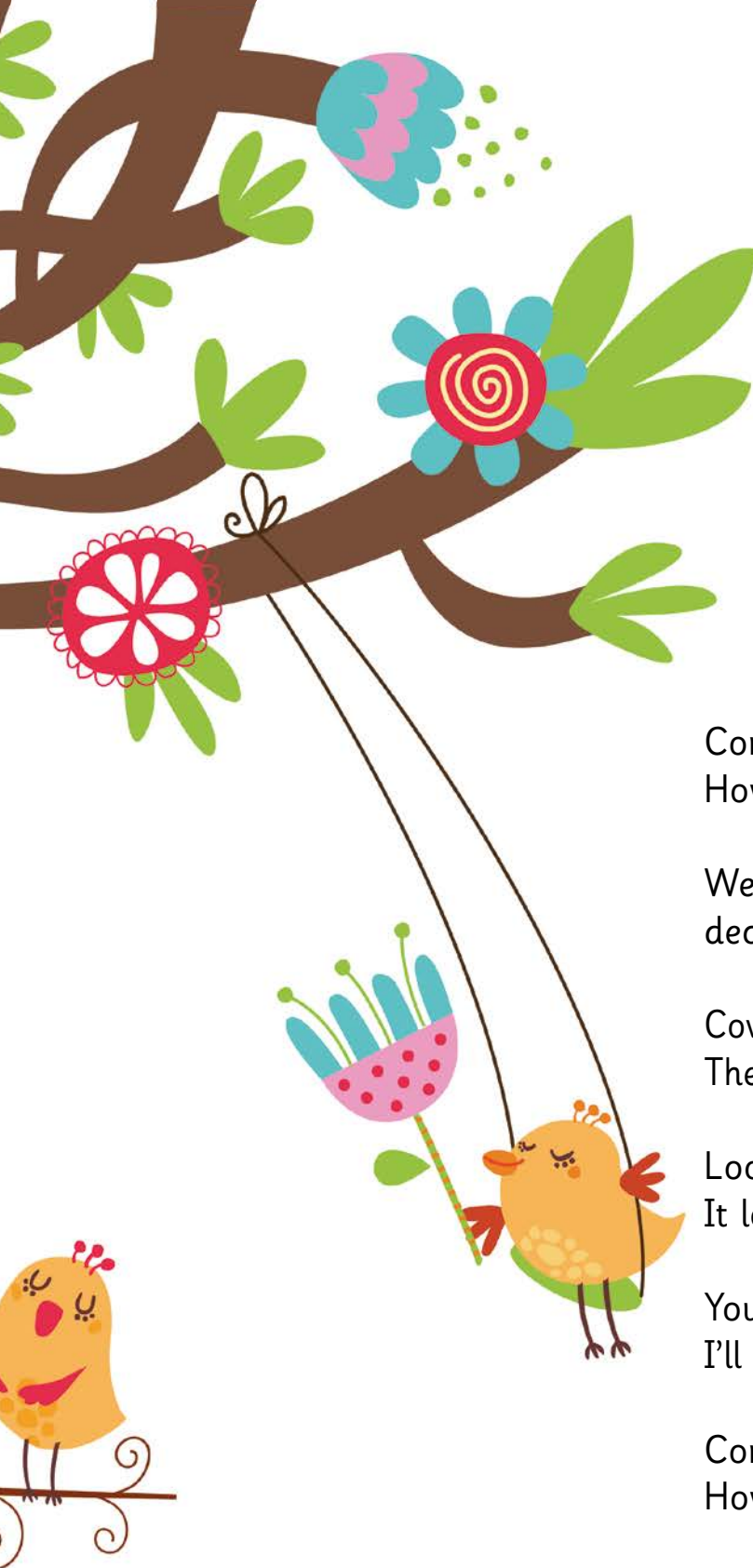

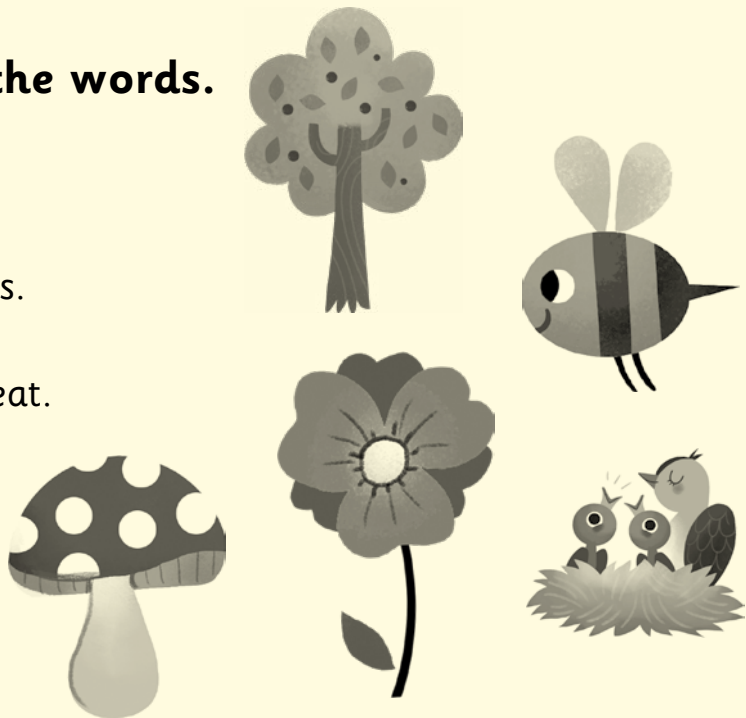

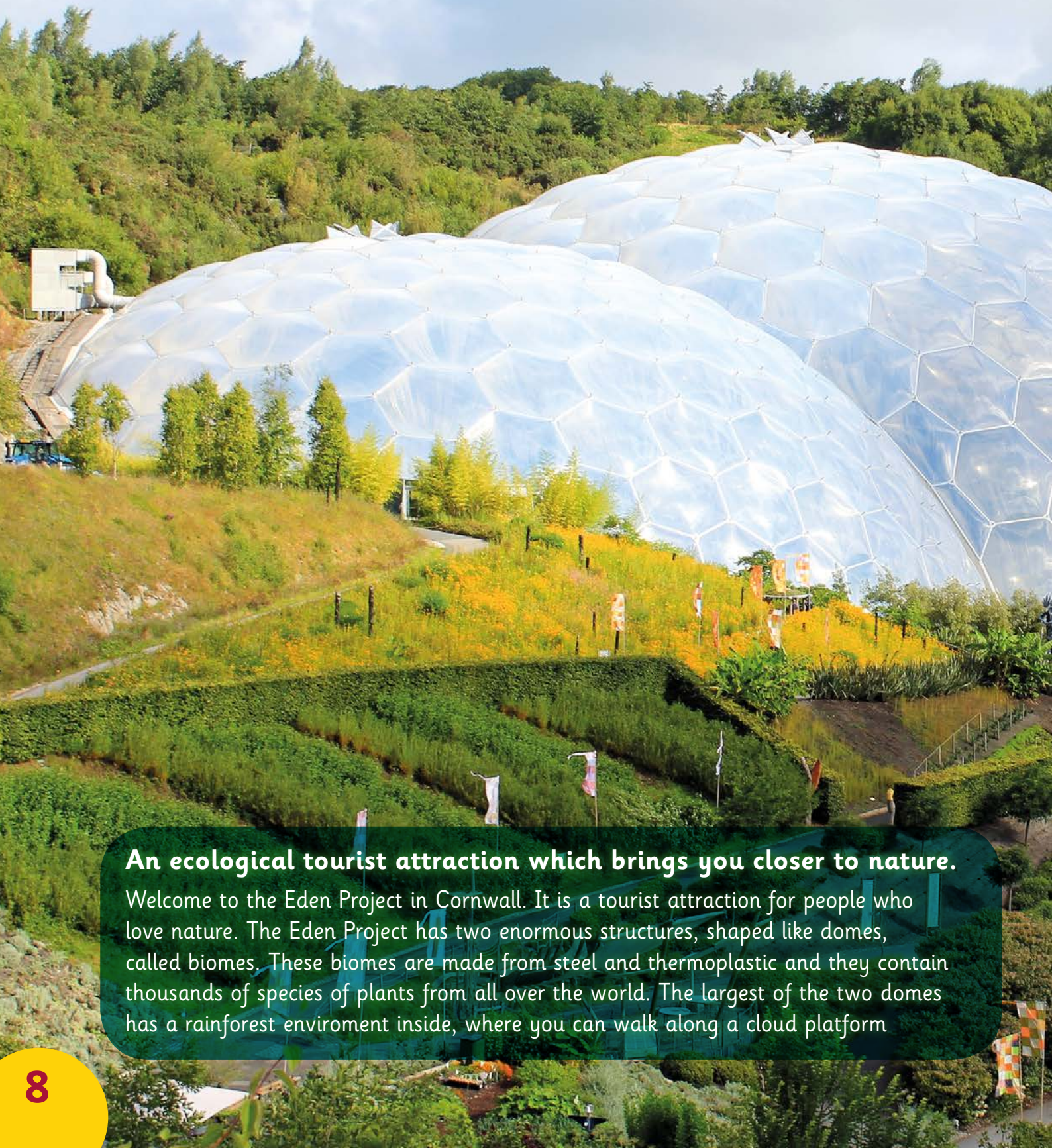

An ecological tourist attraction which brings you closer to nature.

These biomes are made from steel and thermoplastic and they contain thousands of species of plants from all over the world. The largest of the two domes has a rainforest environment inside, where you can walk along a cloud platform.

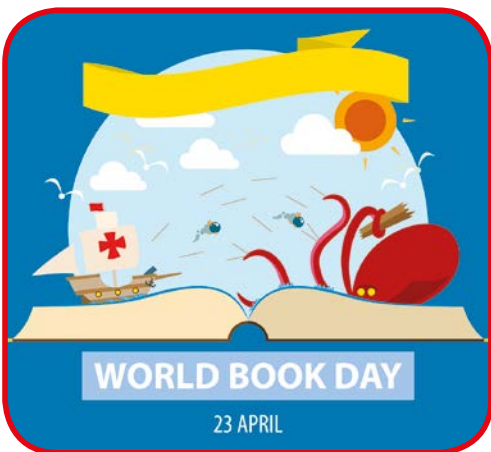
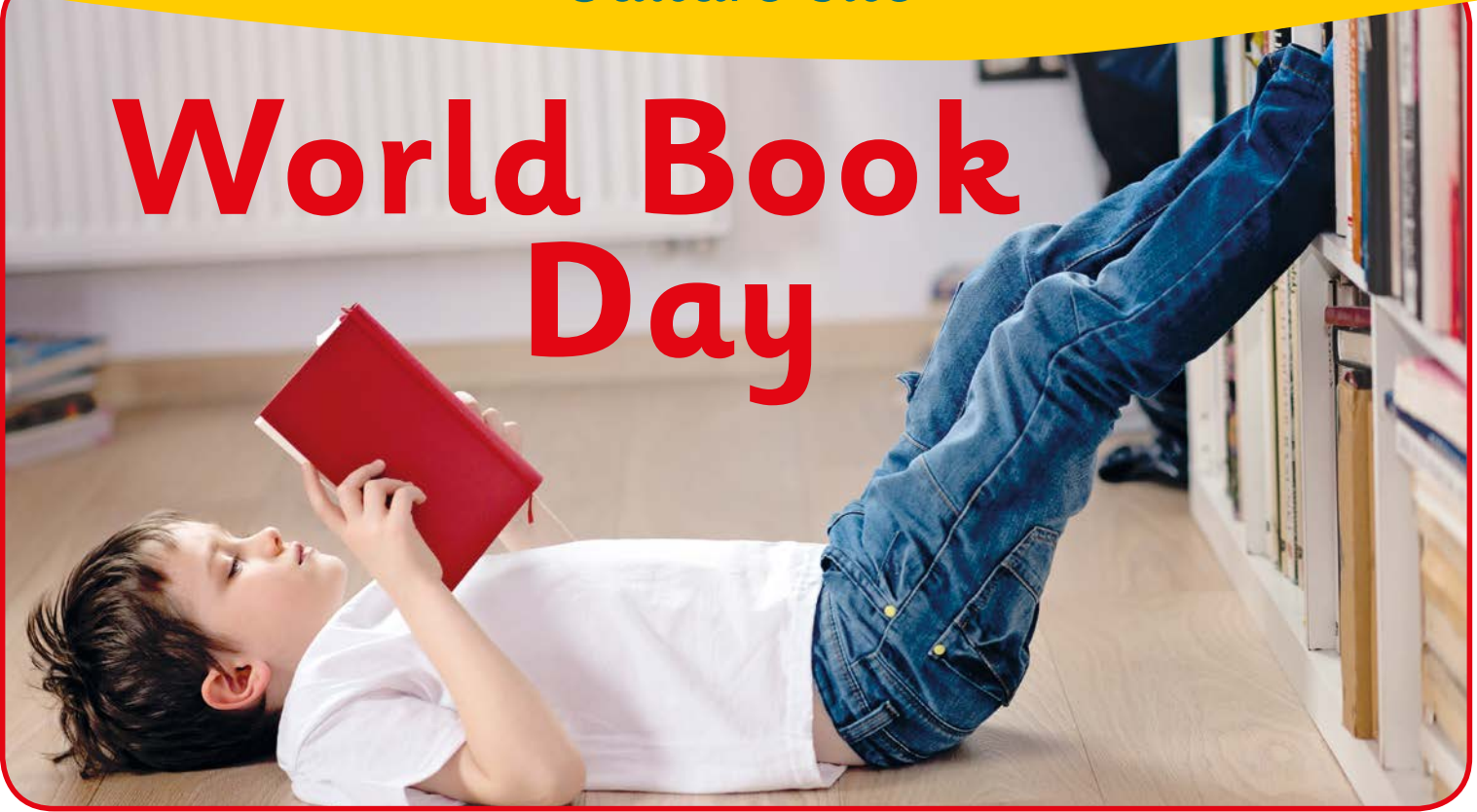

all over the world. The idea behind it is to promote reading and a love of books, and to allow children to choose and read a book of their own.

World book day is celebrated in many ways in schools. Some children go to school dressed as a character from their favourite book. Others write stories of their own and

make them into books. In some schools you can even watch a performance, with the children acting out a particular story.



A gift for everyone

For everyone who takes part in a World Book Day event, there is a special gift. Each child receives a gift voucher, which they can exchange for a book in book shops all over the country.

The child can choose from a list of titles; they can be factual books which talk about nature or science for example, or fiction books which tell stories. The reason for this is that many children don't have enough money to buy books, especially in poor areas, but with a World Book Day voucher everyone can own a book and enjoy reading!

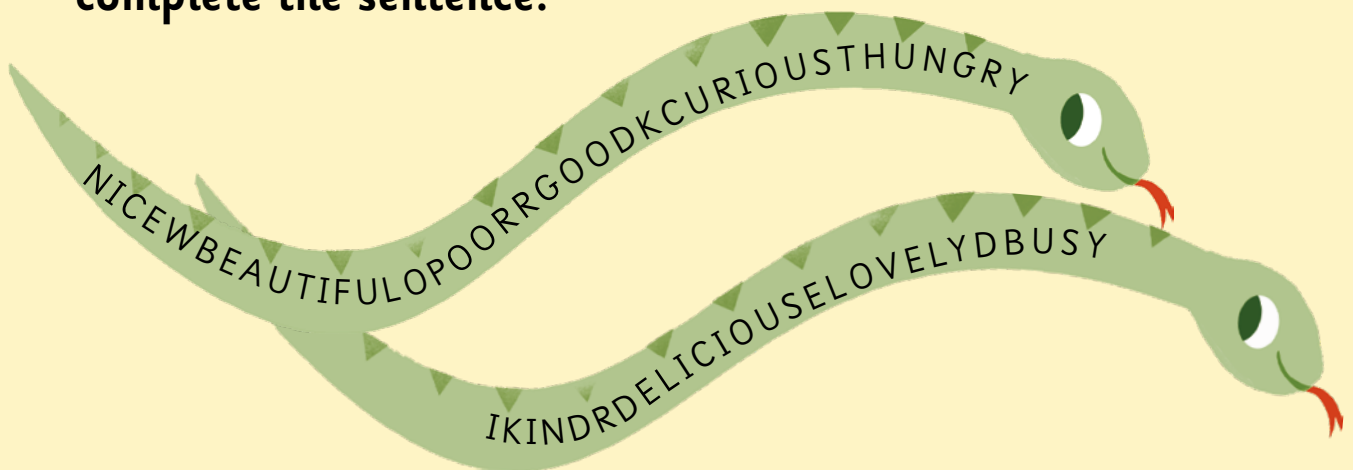

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Chocolate Brownies

If you have lots of chocolate Easter eggs and you don't know what to do with them... why not try this delicious recipe!

Ingredients:

- **125g** unsalted butter
- **200g** chocolate buttons
- **2** eggs (lightly beaten)
- **1** teaspoon vanilla essence
- **1** cup caster sugar
- **1** cup plain flour
- **1** teaspoon raising agent

Method:

1. Heat the oven to 180°C and prepare your baking tray (20cm x 30cm) with kitchen foil.
2. Melt the butter and chocolate over a low heat. Then add the eggs and vanilla essence and mix well.
3. Add the sugar, flour and raising agent, mixing well. Pour the mixture into the baking tray.
4. Bake for 30 minutes.
5. Remove from the oven and cool for two hours.
6. Divide into small portions then eat and... enjoy!
